

# YOUR CLUB BOARD NEEDS YOU

**Your club board plays a vital role in ensuring the success of your clubs.**

**Clubs need enthusiastic people of all ages with diverse backgrounds and skills to serve their club and community as directors.**

The Wests Entertainment Group board is responsible for the overall governance, management and strategic direction of West Tamworth League Club Limited. Wests Entertainment Group operates a business with significant financial, safety and operational risks. All board members should:

- Be financially literate (comfortable with profit and loss statements, balance sheets and cash flow statements, at a minimum)
- Understand and accept directors' duties and governance basics (confidentiality, conflict of interest, due diligence, boardroom etiquette, separation of board vs management responsibilities etc). This can come from other relevant board experience or through education.
- Reinforce the culture and values of the organisation in the way it operates, including having high personal integrity and a communication style that fosters constructive debate
- Have the time and capacity to do the work required

Further, skills that would enhance the expertise of the board include the areas of law, marketing, information technology and also previous experience as a director of an organisation with more than 100 employees. However, this should not discourage candidates who do not have these identified skills or expertise in those areas from applying.

Additionally, directors also accept legal responsibilities to act in accordance with the Corporations Act 2001 and West Tamworth League Club Limited Constitution & By-Laws.

If elected, a director holds office for three (3) years. All new directors must complete mandatory director training within 12-months of their appointment.
