A director holds a responsible position of trust to uphold the traditions and public reputation of Wests, Wests' Diggers and The Courts @ East.

Consisting of five (5) elected and up to two (2) appointed directors, the board meet on the last Wednesday of the month and is the principal governing body for West Tamworth League Club Ltd. Some of the board's powers and duties include:

- The management of business and general affairs of all clubs;
- Control of the property of all clubs;
- Conduct and administration relating to the rights and privileges of members.

Some of a director's roles and responsibilities are:

- To formulate and approve policy;
- Conduct the affairs of all clubs in accordance with the Constitution and in the best interests of all clubs and the members as a whole;
- To advance the image and professionalism of Wests, Wests' Diggers and The Courts @ East.

If elected, a director holds office for three (3) years. All new directors must complete mandatory director training within 12-months of their appointment.
