

# GAMING RULES OF PLAY

Members and guests playing gaming machines at a West Tamworth League Club Ltd venue do so with the understanding that the rules listed below are important conditions of play.

## FAIR PLAY OF GAMING MACHINES

- A person entering cash into a gaming machine with little or no play and without a valid reason is acting against West Tamworth League Club Ltd gaming rules of play.
- CCTV, and staff surveillance will be used in conjunction with electronic monitoring systems to identify unusual behaviour and individuals.
- Members or guests are not permitted to use another person's club membership card or permit another person to use your club membership card.
- Members or guests are not permitted to ask or require any other person to give or lend him or her any money.
- Members or guests are not permitted to give money or lend money to any other person.
- Members or guests are not permitted to take any actions to recover monies claimed from or owed by any other person.
- Members or guests are not permitted to maliciously damage a gaming machine, make a fraudulent claim in relation to a gaming machine, fail to report a gaming machine malfunction, use undue force playing a gaming machine or use a gaming machine for the purpose of money laundering.

## WHAT IS NORMAL SYNDICATE PLAY

- A group of people who pool their own money to play a game.

## WHAT IS NOT NORMAL SYNDICATE PLAY

- Person or persons who compensate others to play on their behalf.

## OUR RULES ON NOT NORMAL SYNDICATE PLAY

- Members or guests cannot hand money or tickets to other members or guests to play machines.
- Members or guests are not permitted to collect tickets and hand them to other members or guests, or insert these tickets into machines for others to play.
- Members or guests are not permitted to collect tickets and cash them in and hand the money to other members or guests.
- Members or guests cannot compensate another person to play machines on their behalf.

## WHAT HAPPENS IN THE EVENT OF A BREACH OF THE ABOVE

Members or guests who have been found to contravene the above rules may be deemed to exhibit conduct unbecoming of a member and face disciplinary action or, in the case of a non-member, be suspended immediately.
